NYS Testing Data:

- The 2024-2025 NYS Math Test scores showed a significant improvement compared to the previous year. In 2023-2024 school year, 39% of students were proficient. This increased to 52.4% in the 2024-2025 school year. The school feels that implementing Number Talks into the classroom, as well as doing 3 Reads, instead of SOLVE has helped contribute to this increase.

- The 2024-2025 NYS ELA Test scores also showed an improvement compared to the previous year. In 2023-2024 school year, 44% of students were proficient. This increased to 54% for the 2025 school year. The school feels that moving more into explicit instruction helped to contribute to this increase. In grades 3-5 the classes worked on RACE. The teachers worked with students on non-fiction text. Students then moved to Fiction texts where they worked on their own.
